IAC will accept for exchange, in November of each year, up to 20% of sculptures on hand to which no re-stocking charge will apply.

IAC will repair, at nominal charge, any product supplied that becomes damaged.

Either party may cancel this agreement by giving thirty days notice in writing to the other.
